Prospective Resident Visits, Move-in & Contractors	<ul> <li>Tours of community allowed with mask, screening, testing and distanced from residents</li> <li>If a new resident is not vaccinated, a quarantine period will be required upon move-in</li> <li>If fully vaccinated prior to move-in, no quarantine required</li> <li>Marketing events allowed. Tour groups must remain small group. Masks and social distance</li> <li>Movers &amp; Contractors allowed with distancing from residents (family movers allowed as visitors)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Tours of community allowed with mask, screening, testing and distanced from residents</li> <li>If a new resident is not vaccinated, a quarantine will be required upon move-in</li> <li>If fully vaccinated prior to move-in, no quarantine required</li> <li>Marketing events allowed. Tour groups must remain small group. Masks and social distance</li> <li>Movers &amp; Contractors allowed with distancing from residents (family movers allowed as visitors)</li> </ul>
